The third season of this lavish drama opens in 1848, when revolution is breaking out across Europe. In Britain, one woman stands between order and chaos: Queen Victoria. Jenna Coleman returns as the young but fearless monarch, facing a crisis that threatens to end her reign. Also returning are Tom Hughes (as Prince Albert), Nell Hudson (as Nancy Skerrett) and Ferdinand Kingsley (as Charles Francatelli). Joining the cast this season are Laurence Fox as the vainglorious Lord Palmerston and Kate Fleetwood as Victoria's troubled half-sister Feodora.

James Watson is the co-discoverer of the structure of DNA. In 1962, Watson shared the Nobel Prize for Physiology or Medicine with Francis Crick and Maurice Wilkins, who, with Rosalind Franklin, provided the data on which the findings were based. Watson wrote *The Double Helix: A Personal Account of the Discovery of the Structure of DNA*, which was published in 1968. This documentary examines the molecular biologist's life and impact on science.

## USS Indianapolis: The Final Chapter

TUE Jan 8 | 10p

In the waning days of World War II, the USS *Indianapolis* had just delivered "Little Boy" — the atomic bomb destined for Hiroshima — when it was torpedoed by a Japanese sub in the Philippine Sea. It sank within minutes, becoming the U.S. Navy's worst single loss of life at sea. In August 2017, an expedition launched by Microsoft co-founder and philanthropist Paul G. Allen discovered the remains of the ship. Now the definitive story of USS *Indianapolis* is finally being told.

## Beyond Pluto | WED Jan 2 | 9p

When the *New Horizons* spacecraft traveled past Pluto in 2015, we were dazzled by the breathtaking images it beamed home — and by the remarkable new details those images revealed about the dwarf planet. On New Year's Day 2019, the craft will fly by an object beyond Pluto known as MU69 — the most distant flyby in NASA's history, at 4 billion miles from Earth — shedding new light on one of the least understood regions of our solar system.
