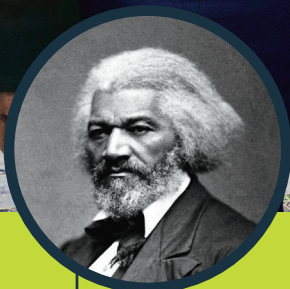

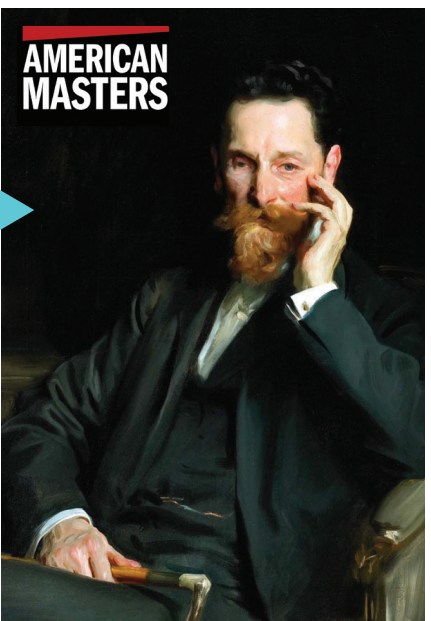
### Joseph Pulitzer

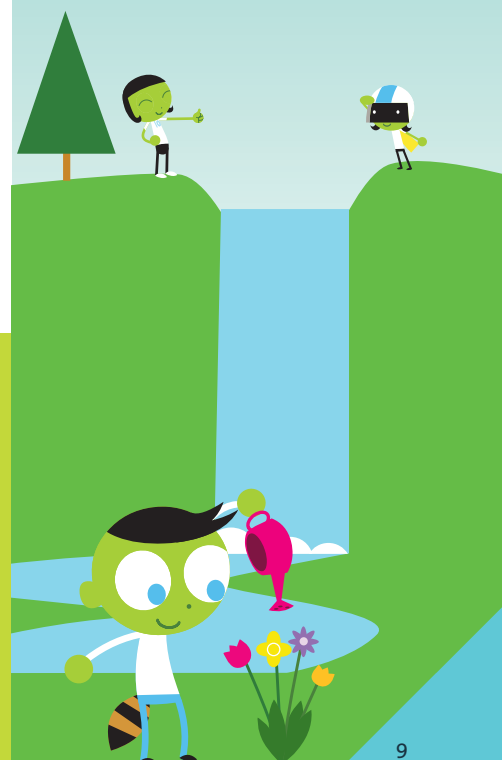
