Following the dissolution of the Oxford City Police at the end of the last season, Season 6 opens in 1969, with the team dispersed and finding their feet in their various new roles. Morse has taken a job as a uniformed officer at the Woodstock police department. Alongside Evans, the new season welcomes back the series' exceptional cast, including Roger Allam as Fred Thursday and Anton Lesser as Reginald Bright.

In 1953, President Eisenhower declared gay men and lesbians to be a threat to national security and therefore unfit for government service. In doing so, he triggered the longest witch-hunt in American history. Over the next four decades, tens of thousands of government workers would lose their jobs for no reason other than their sexual orientation. But the actions of the government had an unintended effect: They inadvertently helped ignite the gay rights movement.



Secrets of the Dead: World War Speed

It's long been known that German soldiers used a methamphetamine, called Pervitin, in World War II. But tales of Nazis on speed have obscured the other side of the story: the massive use of stimulants by British and American troops. Did total war unleash the world's first pharmacological arms race? Tiananmen: Seven Weeks that Changed the World

Uncover the true story of the seven-week period that changed China forever. On June 4, 1989, a student-led democracy demonstration in Beijing came to a violent and bloody end, leaving thousands dead. This documentary recounts the events that led to the Tiananmen Square Massacre through the stories of investigative journalists who were there 30 years ago – and who have been tracking the root cause ever since.
