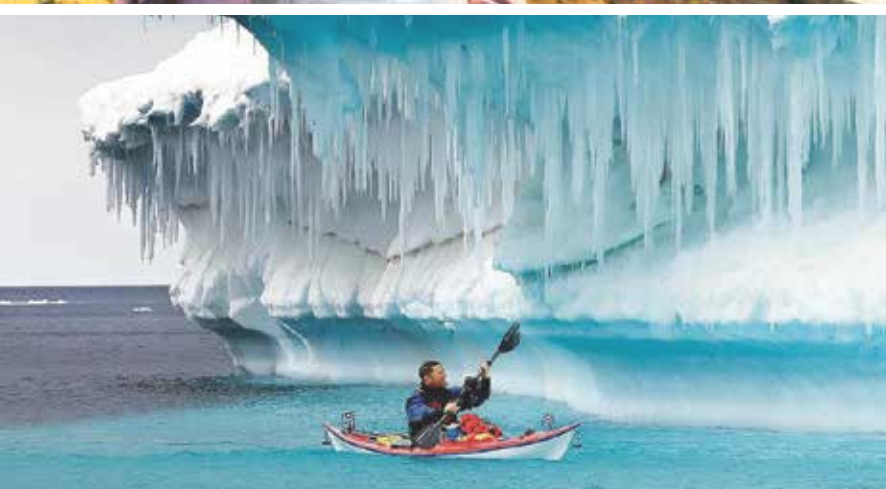


## Sanditon on Masterpiece

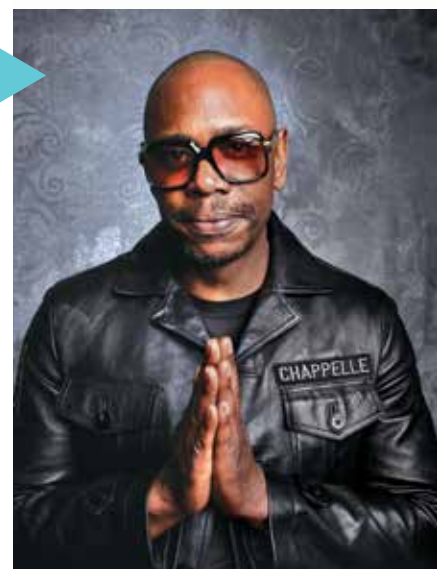

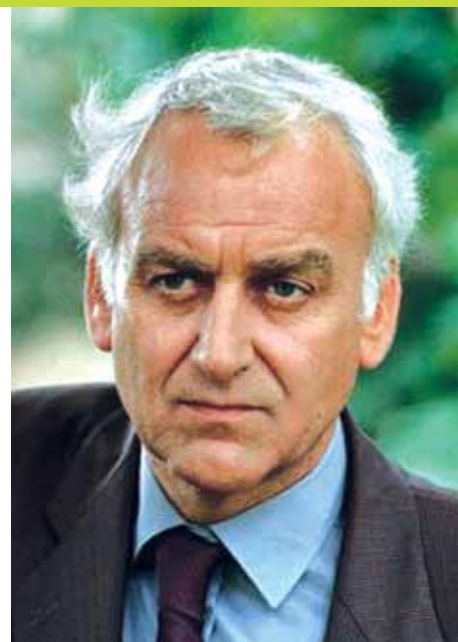
