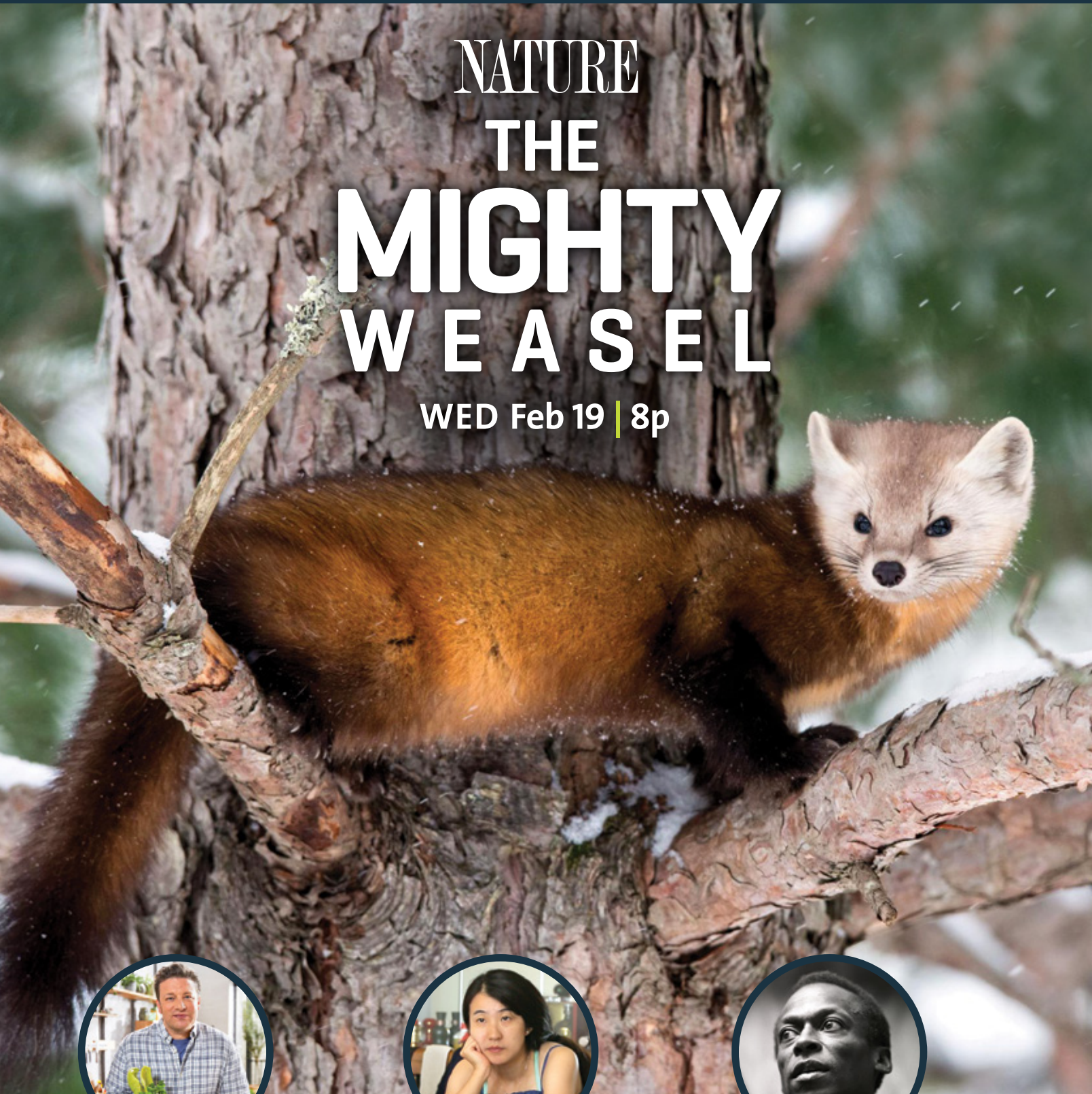

This documentary follows three Chinese women – a lawyer, a journalist and a college professor – who, despite thriving careers, are labeled *sheng nu* (leftover women), a derogatory term for women in their mid-20s and 30s who are not married. With 30 million more men than women in China, social stability is under threat. Single women struggle to stay true to their personal ambitions amid pressure from their families, friends and a government-sponsored campaign to stigmatize unwed women.

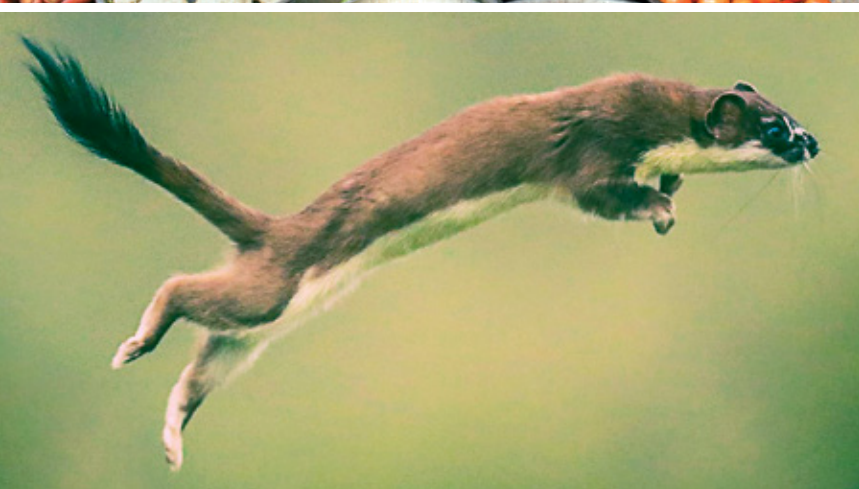
