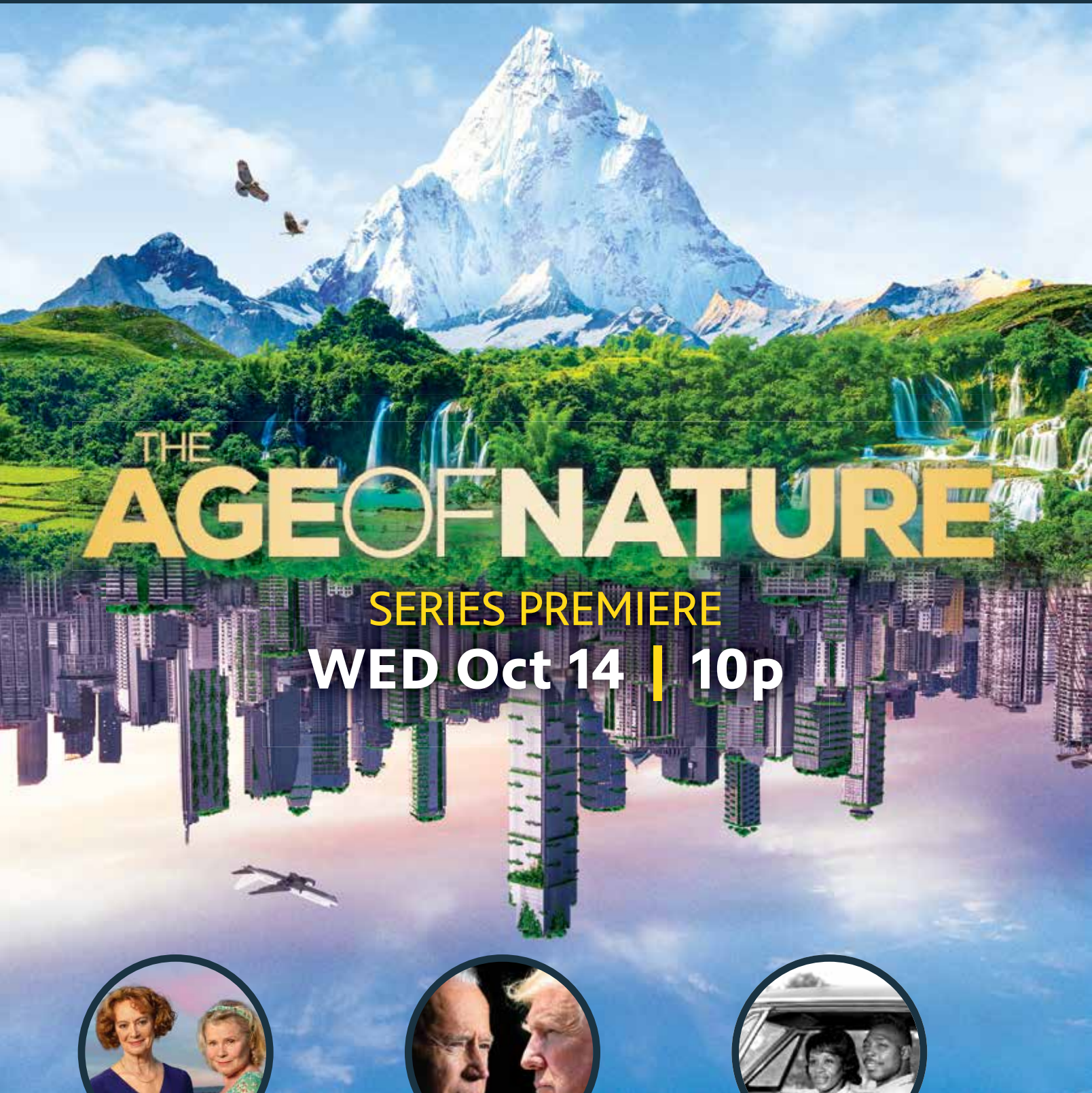

Meanwhile, neighbor Mary (Imelda Staunton) has developed an unhealthy interest in the family's unfolding drama.

Maggie makes it her business to know a little bit about everyone's lives – but she seems to have forgotten the cautionary adage that "people in glass houses shouldn't throw stones."

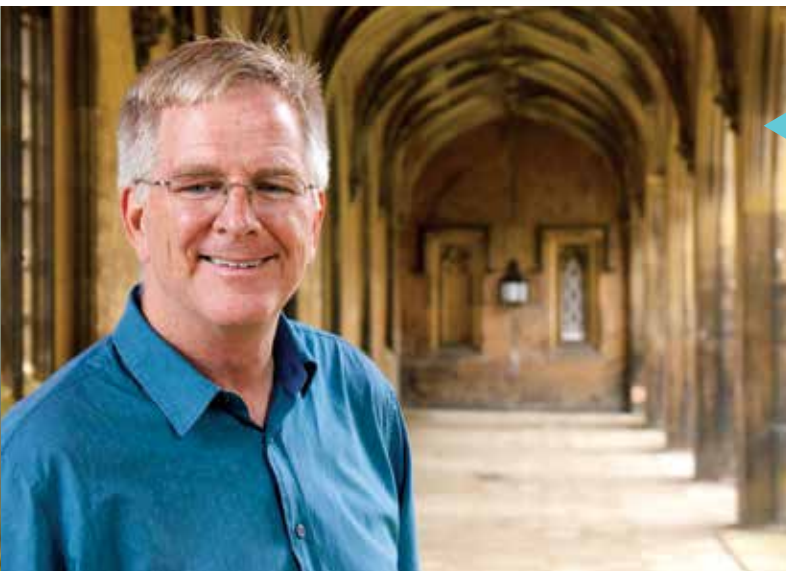

From acclaimed filmmaker Ric Burns, this documentary chronicles the history of African Americans on the road from the 1930s to the late 1960s. Drawing on a rich archive of material from the period, along with riveting oral histories and the on-camera insights of scholars, writers and ordinary travelers, the film explores the genre of travel literature (including "The Green Book") that helped Black travelers navigate Jim Crow America.

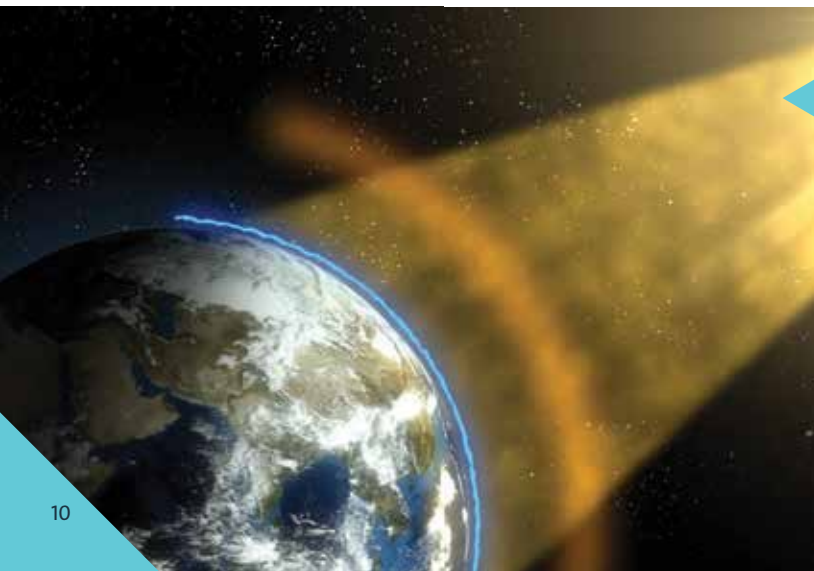
