The plot uses elements of classic detective novels and contains references to Christie's books, such as *The Man in the Brown Suit*, which appeared as a headline in a newspaper clipping. The murder of Florence Nightingale Shore and the character of Mabel Rogers are based on real people and events.

With accompaniment by Pavel Nebolsin on piano, the program also features mezzo-soprano Elena Maximova for duets from Offenbach's *Les Contes d'Hoffmann* and Tchaikovsky's *The Queen of Spades*.
