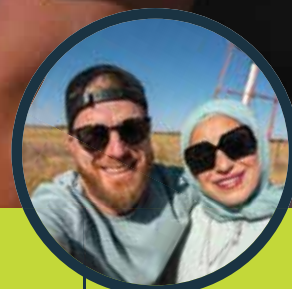

Take a summer road trip with two new travel series beginning Tuesday, July 5, at 9:00 p.m. First, hit the trail with *America Outdoors with Baratunde Thurston*. This six-part series is hosted by *New York Times* bestselling author and outdoor enthusiast Baratunde Thurston. The series follows him on an adventure-filled journey to explore the diverse array of regions across the U.S. and how those landscapes shape the way Americans work, play and interact with the outdoors. From wilderness pilots flying “below the rim” in Idaho to coal miners turned beekeepers in Appalachia to Black surfers catching waves in Los Angeles, Thurston introduces viewers to a vivid cast of characters.

Then, at 10:00 p.m., buckle up for *The Great Muslim American Road Trip*. Follow a millennial Muslim American couple on a cross-country journey along historic Route 66. As they meet new friends and explore more than a dozen stops, Mona and Sebastian weave a colorful story about what it means to be Muslim in America today.

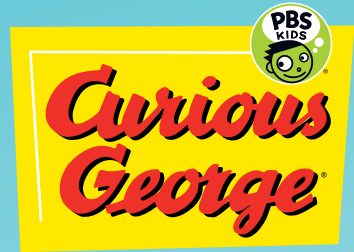

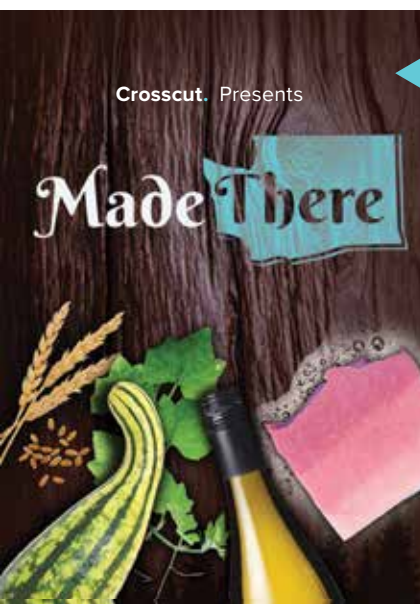

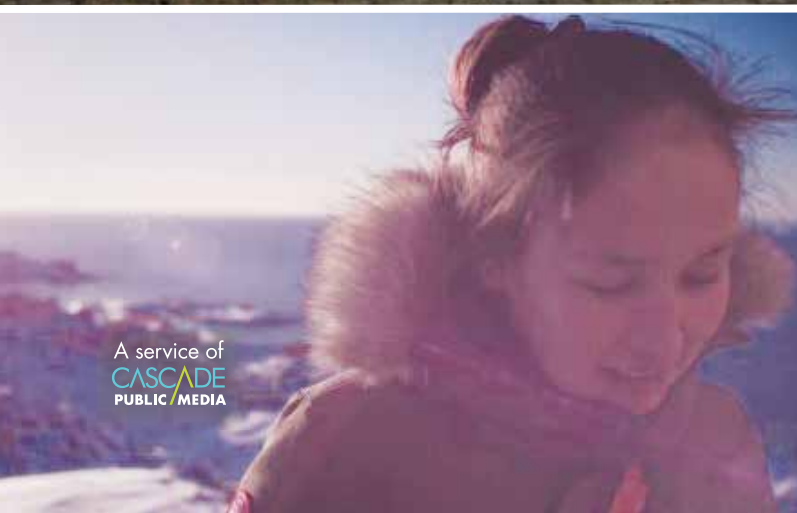

Archive footage of the countrywide celebrations opens “Winter’s Yearning,” but the inevitable delays result in the small fishing community being on standby for years. In order to get a better understanding of what life is like in Maniitsoq, the narrative is divided among three individuals: a young woman working in the factory, a social worker and the town’s aluminum coordinator.
